NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BY-LAW NO. L.S.P.-3431-177 (Under the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18)

TAKE NOTICE that on May 14, 2013, London City Council adopted By-law No. L.S.P.-3431-177 which designates the Blackfriars/Petersville Heritage Conservation Study Area under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT any person or public body who objects to the By-law may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) by filing a notice of appeal with the City Clerk, Catharine Saunders, 3rd Floor, 300 Dufferin Avenue, London, Ontario, N6A 4L9 no later than 4:30 p.m. on July 8, 2013.

The Notice of Appeal must set out the objection to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objection; and be accompanied by the \$125.00 fee prescribed under the *Ontario Municipal Board Act* in the form of a certified cheque or money order payable to the Minister of Finance.

The purpose of this by-law is to prohibit or set limitations on any alterations, erections, demolitions or removals of buildings or structures within the heritage conservation study area for up to one year.

The Blackfriars/Petersville Heritage Conservation Study Area is generally bounded by the Canadian Pacific Railway to the north, the Thames River to the east and south and the flood plain boundary to the west, as shown on Schedule "A" in the by-law.

A copy of By-law L.S.P.-3431-177 and the council resolution are enclosed.
