CULTURAL PROGRAMS NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REPEAL A BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Eramosa intends to repeal the By-law designating the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as having architectural and/or historical value or interest so that the property will no longer be deemed to be of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.Q.18 as amended

THE BOW STRING BRIDGE IN EDEN MILLS, TOWNSHIP OF ERAMOSA shall no longer be designated pursuant to Section 31 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18 as amended. This Bridge, listed as Bridge No. 81 on the Ontario list of Heritage Bridges, is on former Wellington County Road 28, York Street, between Concessions II and III, in the settlement area of Eden Mills, over the Eramosa River. It is a single-span, bow string or concrete truss bridge, built in 1913 from a design by Bowman and Connor, Engineers, to replace a wooden bridge washed away in Spring floods in 1912. It is reinforced concrete with joined trusses and short abutments.

Any person may, within thirty (30) days of the publication of this Notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Eramosa, a notice of his or her objection to the proposed repeal of the By-law together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a notice of objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Eramosa shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a Hearing.
