## **NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REPEAL BY-LAW 1982-06**

## Being a By-law to Designate the Property Municipally Known as 2 Water Street (Dr. Spohn Residence) under the Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the Town of Penetanguishene will consider repealing By-law 1982-06 being a By-law to designate 2 Water Street (Dr. Spohn Residence) under the Ontario Heritage Act at their meeting to be held on Wednesday, January 12, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. at the Penetanguishene Townhall, 10 Robert Street West, Penetanguishene.

The proposed repealing By-law is being considered as the original reasons for designation in 1982 no longer exist in their original state:

- Bargeboard on the main gable and east facing gable;
- Replica finials as referenced in the designation By-law.

The property will be considered for future heritage recognition under an established Recognition Program through the Town as a place of interest.

Notice of objections to the repealing By-law may be submitted to the Clerk prior to December 17, 2010.
