**A By-Law to designate certain property within the
Municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest**

WHEREAS Chapter 337 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, designate property within the Municipality to be of historical or architectural value or interest.

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate certain property within the Municipality was served on the owner of the property and the Ontario Heritage Foundation, on May 25, 1990 and was published in the Perth Courier May 31, June 6th and June 13th, 1990.

AND WHEREAS no objections were received against the designation of the said property as a result of the aforementioned notices:

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following property be and is hereby designated to be of historic or architectural value or interest:

Description: The Haggart Dam Mill Site on Mill Street, Plan 8828.

Owner: Town Of Perth

REASON FOR DESIGNATION:

This flour mill was built in the 1840's on the Tay River and the foundation is still visible.


