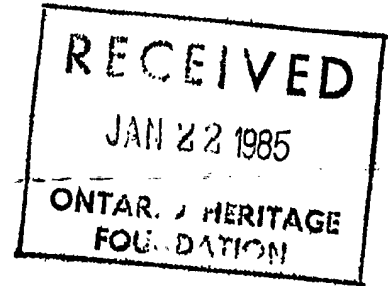

NOTICE

TOWNSHIP OF KENYON

Notice is hereby given that the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Kenyon intends to pass a By-Law on December 14, 1984 pursuant to Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act RSO 1980, to designate the below listed property to be of historic and architectural value and interest.

Property to be Designated

That part of Lot Number 24 in the 8th Concession of the Township of Kenyon which land is occupied by the Glengarry Pioneer Museum in the hamlet of Dunvegan. The subject lands are more particularly described in Instruments numbered 8405, 8742 and 27240 registered in the Registry Office for Glengarry.

Said designation is deemed necessary for the restoration and preservation of the museum buildings which because of their original use and construction are a unique part of our heritage.

Persons wishing to give notice of objection to the passing of said By-Law have until December 13, 1984 to serve such notice to the Township Clerk stating the reasons thereof and all relevant facts.
