Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Glengarry, on the 19th day of July 1999, decided to to designate the structure know Municipaly as the Grandstand at the Maxville Fair Grounds, as a structure of architectural and historic value under the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18

The structure was originally constructed by the Kenyon Agricultural Society as a classic turn of the century grandstand to accommodate the ever larger crowds attending the annual Maxville and district agricultural fair which has been ongoing for the past 100 years, and for the past 52 years as a most valuable facility for the largest Highland Games in the world, the Glengarry Highland Games.

In their refurbishment of the grandstand in the 1950's, the Kenyon Agricultural Society and the Highland Games Committee have maintained and enhanced the historical design features and building materials that make this structure a striking example of graceful early architecture.
