By-Law No. 1832 (1985)

By-law to designate 79 Victoria Street West,
in the Town of Wingham.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes council of a Municipality to designate property within the Municipality to be of historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of the Town of Wingham deems it desirable to designate 79 Victoria Street West, to be of historic and architectural value and interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the Town of Wingham has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29 (3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., Chapter 337.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WINGHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest.
2. Section 33 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 337, shall apply only to the following feature of the said property:
The cast iron fence on the Victoria Street face;
3. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Registry Office.
4. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served on The Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
5. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham.

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the Town of Wingham, in the County of Huron and Province of Ontario and being composed of part of the Northwest half of Lot #480 on the West side of Minnie Street in the Government Survey in the said Town of Wingham, now plan 410, more particularly described as follows:
