within Norfolk County under the Ontario Heritage Act**

Please be advised that the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County intends to designate the following two properties within Norfolk County under the Ontario Heritage Act:

1. McInnes/Wotten Residence (MapleLodge) 1872
2. Industry Farm/Poor House/County Home/Burying Ground

A Notice of Objection to the designations may be served on the Clerk no later than the 18th day of January, 2007.

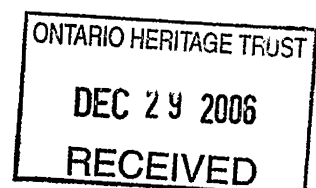

ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT

NOTICE OF INTENTION

TO DESIGNATE THE INDUSTRY FARM / POOR HOUSE / COUNTY HOME BURYING GROUND

TAKE NOTICE THAT, the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, being Part of Lot 16, in the Gore, Geographic Township of Woodhouse, now Norfolk County, designated as Part 1, 37R-9582, municipally located behind 500 Queensway West, Simcoe, Ontario, within Norfolk County.

The property is recognized to be of historical significance due to its fascinating history of the local social welfare. In 1868 County Council purchased 100 acres for the establishment of an Industrial Farm and Poor House whose residents included the less fortunate. To date, of the 372 deaths identified at the Poor House, 219 recorded burials are represented by a collection of 28 grave markers located on the property.

Further information respecting the proposed designation is available at the Clerk's Office, Norfolk County Administration Building, 50 Colborne Street South, Simcoe.

Any person who objects to the proposed designation may serve on the Clerk of Norfolk County not later than the 18th day of January, 2007, a notice of objection setting out the reason for objection and all relevant facts.
