CITY OF NANTICOKE

BY-LAW NO. 2-88

Being a by-law to designate the property, Parcel 8-1, Section D-2, being part of Unit 8, Plan D-37-2 (Townsend), City of Nanticoke, in the Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk, designated as Part 1 of Plan 37R-2819, as a property of historic and architectural value. (The Rockford School/Vasseur Residence).

WHEREAS the <u>Ontario Heritage Act</u>, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337, as amended, provides for the conservation, protection and preservation of the heritage of Ontario, and provides that the Council of a municipality may designate a property within the municipality to be of historic and architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Nanticoke deems it desirable to designate the property being Parcel 8-1, Section D-2, being part of Unit 8, Plan D-37-2 (Townsend), City of Nanticoke, in the Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk, designated at Part 1 of Plan 37R-2819, as property of historic and architectural value and interest;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by Part IV of the <u>Ontario</u> <u>Heritage Act</u>, R.S.O. 1980 have been carried out and no Notice of <u>Objection</u> to the Notice of Intention to Designate the aforementioned property was received;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Nanticoke hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the property known locally as the Rockford School/Vasseur Residence being Parcel 8-1, Section D-2, being part of Unit 8, Plan D-37-2 (Townsend), City of Nanticoke, in the Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk, designated as Part 1 of Plan 37R-2819, as registered in the Land Titles Division of Haldimand-Norfolk (No. 37), be hereby designated as a property of historic and architectural value and interest for the purposes of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.
- THAT a copy of this by-law together with Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, setting out the reasons for designation, shall be registered against the property affected and deposited in the Land Titles Division of Haldimand-Norfolk (No. 37) and served upon the owner and the Ontario Heritage Foundation.

- 3. THAT a notice of this by-law shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Nanticoke.
- 4. THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its final passing thereof.

## ROCKFORD SCHOO1/VASSEUR RESIDENCE

REASONS FOR DESIGNATION UNDER THE <u>ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT</u>, R.S.O. 1980, CHAPTER 337.

The property being Parcel 8-1, Section D-2, being part of Unit 8, Plan D-37-2 (Townsend), City of Nanticoke, in the Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk, designated as Part 1 of Plan 37R-2819, as registered in the Land Titles Division of Haldimand-Norfolk (No. 37).

The property known locally as the Rockford School is a good example of Victorian architecture and is the only surviving building of the Village of Rockford, being designated for the following features:

1.) All four elevations of the school including the soffits and windows.
