## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobalt intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 5.0. Chapter 122.

Municipal Address: 17 Prospect Avenue, Cobalt, Ontario.
Coniagas Headframe and Giachino Grocery Store.

## Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Coniagas Headframe and Giachino Grocery Store is recommended for designation for architectural and historical reasons. It is a highly unusual building, incorporating both a headframe and a grocery store, with the headframe jutting out of the store's flat roof with tin clad sloping walls, gable headed windows and gable roof. The Headframe recalls to us the arrogance of the early mining companies who considered it their due to blast in centre Cobalt "so long as a warning signal be sounded" and the grocery store bears witness to the ingenuity of one of Cobalt's early citizens, Anthony Giachino, who realized that the cold mine air could be used to chill perishables. Together they form a unique architectural artifact and element of Cobalt's historical context.
