## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

**To:** Ontario Heritage Foundation 77 Bloor Street West Toronto, Ontario M7A 2T9

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia intends to designate the property including lands and buildings, at the following Municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act 1990, Section 29 (1) Chapter 0.18.

Reasons for Proposed Designation

## **Historical Reasons:**

Date of Construction: Registry 1887

Property belong to Frank Smith. Purchased by Christina Burt in 1893 and sold to Ray Barnes in 1934. Mr. Barnes was an employee of Imperial Oil. Other owners were Margaret Peckard, Stanley and Annabella McLachlan. This house is over 100 years old.

## The Architectural Reasons:

- 1. Tall vertical windows with entablature heads. Window on porch has a section of stained glass typical of the day.
- 2. Classical columns support the verandah.
- 3. Salt box roof is graced with a decorative frieze.
- 4. A delightful side porch is decorated in keeping with the front verandah.

Any persons may before the 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2002, send by registered mail or deliver to the Administrator Clerk of the Town of Petrolia, notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. When a Notice of Objection has been received, the Council of the Town of Petrolia will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing and report.
