



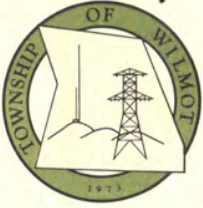

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILMOT

BY-LAW NO. 93-32

BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE
GINGERICH/SASONOW-KNIGHT PROPERTY,
(SHADYBROOK COURT, MANNHEIM), IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF WILMOT, TO BE OF
HISTORIC AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE AND
INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 authorizes Council of a Municipality to designate property within the Municipality to be of historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council for The Corporation of the Township of Wilmot deems it desirable to designate the Gingerich/Sasonow-Knight Property, built in 1863, to be of historic and architectural value and interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the Township of Wilmot has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990.


NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILMOT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest.

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2. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Wilmot.





Schedule "A"

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Township of Wilmot, in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo and Province of Ontario and being composed of Part of Lot Number 2, South of Bleam's Road, in the said Township of Wilmot and being more particularly described as Part 1 on Plan 58R-4213.

TOGETHER WITH a right-of-way over Part of said Lot 2, more particularly described as Part 1 on Plan 58R-3633.

TOGETHER WITH AN EASEMENT in common with all others entitled to use the same in, under and upon a part of said Lot 2, more particularly described as Parts 2 and 3 on Plan 58R-4213 for the purpose of a water pipe line and of keeping and maintaining it at all times in good condition and repair and for every such purpose of the owner or owners from time to time, their servants, employees and workmen.
