**Notice of Intention
to Designate**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation
of the Township of South Dumfries intends to
designate the property, including lands and buildings,
at the following municipal address as a property of ar-
chitectural and/or historical value or interest under
Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O.
Chapter 122, 3 Main Street South, St. George, On-
tario.

Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The structure (Sunnyside) was con-
structed in 1888 by Dr. E. E. Kitchen and
is an excellent example of a modern
Canadian Home of the period in regards
to architectural design, interior and ex-
terior detail. In addition, the property is
situate in the main business area of St.
George and will act as a focal point for
the downtown area, and in the opinion of
Council should be preserved and restored.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first
publication of this notice, send by registered mail or
deliver to the Clerk of the Township of South Dum-
fries notice of his or her objection to the proposed
designation together with a statement of the reasons
for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a notice
of objection is received, the Council of the Corpora-
tion of the Township of South Dumfries shall refer the
matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hear-
ing.
