## CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH DUMFRIES

## BY-LAW NUMBER 34-83

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS PART OF LOT 14, CONCESSION 3 AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND/OR HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Dumfries has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as Part of Lot 14, Concession 3 and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Dumfries enacts as follows:

- 1. There is designated as being of architectural and/or historical value or interest the real property more particularly described as follows: Adelaide Hunter Hoodless Homestead known as Part of Lot 14, Concession 3, Blue Lake Road (County of Brant Road #35), Township of South Dumfries composed of 3.00 acres - 498' x 262.80' owned by Federated Women's Institutes of Canada.
- The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
