THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH STORMONT

BY-LAW NO. 48-2000

a by-law to designate the property known municipally as Plan 292, Block A, geographic Township of Cornwall, that being Ault Park and Museum Complex, as being of historical value.

WHEREAS

the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18, s.29, authorizes Council to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS

Council has authorized the notice of intention to designate the property known as Plan 292, Block A, geographic Township of Cornwall;

AND WHEREAS

no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Stormont enacts as follows:

- To designate as historical value, the Ault Park and Museum 1) Complex owned by the Corporation of the Township of South Stormont and known as Ault Park and Museum Complex at 16355 and 16361 Fran Laflamme Drive, geographic Township of Cornwall.
- A copy of this by-law be registered against the property as 2) described in paragraph 1.
- The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be 3) served on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the Standard Freeholder.

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME, this 30th day of August, 2000.
