THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOSA

BY-LAW NO. 26/92

A by-law to Designate the property known municipally as Part of Lot 1, Concession 8, RP 34R552 Part 1, as being of Architectural and Historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29(1) of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1990 Chapter O.18 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Mosa has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as Burns Presbyterian Church at Part of Lot 1, Concession 8, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality;


THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Mosa enacts as follows;

1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as Burns Presbyterian Church at Part of Lot 1, Concession 8, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto.
2. The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
