NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Thessalon intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S. O. Chapter 122.

Thessalon Union Public Library 234 Main Street, Plan 8, Lot 28

The Thessalon Union Public Library, built in 1900 and situated on the Main Street, is recommended for designation for architectural reasons, as it is one of the few remaining buildings of that design. The detailing found on the exterior of the building was skillfully applied using local materials and craftsmanship. Historically, the building has served over the years as a church, a high school, a community hall, a gymnasium, an office, a public school, as well as an art room, before becoming a library.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Thessalon notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Thessalon shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
