



BY-LAW NUMBER 198-06

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT

To designate the Brant Bowstring Bridge on Colborne Street East, geographic Township of Brantford, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act.

WHEREAS a request was received from the County of Brant Heritage Committee to designate the Brant Bowstring Bridge under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act;

AND WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act empowers a Council of a municipality to pass bylaws to designate properties of historical or architectural interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act;

AND WHEREAS the Notice of Intention to Designate the Brant Bowstring Bridge was served on the Owner of the property, the Ontario Heritage Trust, and was published in the Brantford Expositor as required by the Ontario Heritage Act:

AND WHEREAS the reasons for designation are attached as Schedule "A" to the bylaw;

AND WHEREAS no objection to the notice for designation has been received by the Clerk of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. **THAT** the Brant Bowstring Bridge described as Part of the John Likens Tract and Daniel Hawley Tract and known as part of Colborne Street East, in the geographic Township of Brantford, County of Brant, part of PIN 32227-0001, be designated under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as a property of historical and architectural significance as described in Schedule "A" attached to this bylaw:
- 2. **THAT** the Clerk shall register a copy of this by-law, together with its Schedules against the title of the lands in the Land Registry Office for the County of Brant and shall serve a copy of the by-law together with its schedules, to the owner of the land and the Ontario Heritage Trust and to publish a notice of the passing of this by-law in the Brantford Expositor.

READ a first and second time, this 19th day of September, 2006.

READ a third time and finally passed in Council, this 19th day of September, 2006.
