TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Port
Hope intends to designate the property including the lands and buildings, at the
following municipal address(es) as a property of architectural and/or historical
value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990.

43-45 Dorset Street West - This property has an interesting history in the
early life of Port Hope and its bustling commercial activity. When the lot
was obtained in 1859, it was next to the Midland Railway tracks and close
to the Grand Trunk Station, an ideal site for a railway inn. The building's
unusual shape leads to curious but delightful details such as the rounded
corner of red brick in Flemish bond, softening the acute angle of the
northeast corner.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Municipality of Port Hope before the 29th day of June, 2002.
