BY-LAW NO. 1995-4433

BEING A BY-LAW to repeal B/L No. 1989-3341 designating 125 Cedar Street South as being of

architectural and historic value in the City of Timmins.

WHEREAS Section 31 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18 and amendments

thereto authorizes Councils for municipalities to repeal by-laws designating property.

AND WHEREAS Notice of Council's intention to repeal the By-law designating 125 Cedar Street

South as being of architectural and historic value was published in the Daily Press in accordance

with Section 31(3)(b) of the Ontario Heritage Act.

AND WHEREAS no one served notice of an objection to the repealing By-law No. 1989-3341 on

the Clerk for the Corporation of the City of Timmins.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Timmins enacts as follows:

1. THAT By-law No. 1989-3341 designating 125 Cedar Street South as being of architectural

and historic value be and is hereby repealed.

2. This By-law shall be registered on title in the Land Titles Office in Cochrane.

3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served on the

owners of the property described in Clause 1 hereto and on the Ontario Heritage

Foundation and to cause notice of passing of this By-law to be published in the Daily

Press.

4. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of passage.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed this 8th day of May, 1995.
