## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Townships of Elzevir and Grimsthorpe intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value and interest under Part! of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

- Lot 2, Range 1, Plan 18 (Plan of Queensborough), Part Lot 14, (a) Concession 1, Township of Elzevir (McMurray's Store).
- Reasons for the Proposed Designation: It was built in approximately (b) 1850 and is one of the oldest buildings in the Hamlet of Queensborough It is a well-known local landmark, and is an early example of rural design, skillfully using local material and craftmanship. Historically the building has served as a focal point for activities, having been used as a hotel for approximately its first seventy years, before being converted to a store, of which use it was made for approximately the next sixty years. This building, the former "McMurray's Store" (Diamond Hotel) is an historically significant building that retains fine examples of 19th century craftmanship in woodwork and timber-frame construction.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Townships of Elzevir and Grimsthorpe before the 6th day of April, 1989.
