Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Campbellford intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

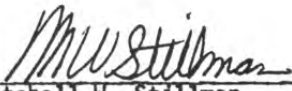
The property to be designated is the old Campbellford Firehall including the Tower which is on Saskatoon Avenue in the said Town of Campbellford. The property may be more particularly described as part of Lot 7 East Factory Block, Registered Plan 112.

The reasons for the proposed designation are as follows:

The firehall was originally the Water Works and Electric Light Station when it was built in 1889. The most outstanding architectural feature is the unique hose drying tower. The building is constructed of red brick with limestone sills. Finely detailed brickwork outline the arches of the main door and windows. The original roof of the main building is metal with standing seams, while the tower roof is in the shape of an inverted onion. The site is of local historical interest as a reminder of the significance of water power to the early growth of the Town.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Campbellford before the 16th day of September, 1983.
