## CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF HASTINGS BY-LAW 1985-08

A By-Law to designate certain properties in the Village of Hastings, under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974

WHEREAS, under authority of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, Municipalities may designate certain properties as being of historic or architectural significance

THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Hastings enacts as follows:

The following property is designated as being of historic or architectural significance.

## THE PROPERTY - THE FOWLDS HOUSE, 33 Front Street

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being within the Village of Hastings in the County of Northumberland and Province of Ontario and being composed of Lot 51 in Block "M" of Plan 33 of the Village of Hastings.

## REASON FOR DESIGNATION

The house was built for William Fowlds, one of the original permanent residents of the Village of Hastings in 1859-1860 by McDowell & Bartley. It is a fine example of the type of houses built in that era. The brick is locally made, on site at the time of construction.
