CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CAMPBELLFORD

BY-LAW #1986-31

Being a by-law to designate the property  
known municipally as 308 Grand Road as  
being of architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act 1974 authorizes the Council of the municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Campbellford has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as 308 Grand Road and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the aforesaid property and caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each three consecutive week;


AND WHEREAS a notice of objection of proposed designation have been filed and withdrawn;


THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Campbellford hereby enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of architectural value or interest the real property known as 308 Grand Road, more particularly described as Plan 112, East Part Lot D, Block 34, Town of Campbellford.
2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Registry Office.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

By-law read a first and second time this 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 1986.


By-law read a third time and passed this 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 1986.
