RE: Request to Demolish Designated Heritage Building at 13941 Airport Road Master's House, Town of Caledon

At its meeting on December 12, 2017, Council consented to an application to demolish the heritage designated building at 13941 Airport Road, subject to the following recommendations:

- The building shall be recorded with accurate measured drawings with particular attention to the plan relationship between the Basement and the Ground Floor of the main house. A qualified heritage consultant shall be engaged to coordinate the removal in order to record the as built condition;
- The demolition shall be undertaken carefully in order to allow a record of the extent and detail of the unburnt mud (adobe) structure, and other heritage features that may be exposed in the process;
- Demolition shall not proceed until the contents of the house are removed;
- · Document the demolition with overall and detail photography;
- Modify record drawings accordingly following demolition;
- Provide the Town with a bound copy of these drawing and photographic records upon completion.
- Samples of unburnt mud bricks shall be saved and turned over to the Town.
