THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH DUMFRIES

BY-LAW 25-86

A By-law to designate the property known municipally as Pt. Lot 7, Concession 3, Township of South Dumfries as being of Architectural and Historical Value and Interest

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-law to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon to be of architectural or historic value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Dumfries has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as Concession 3, Part Lot 7, South Dumfries Township and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Dumfries enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as The Old School at Concession 3, Part Lot 7, Township of South Dumfries and more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto.
2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the property Land Registry Office.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

Read a first and second time this 19th day of August 1986.

Read a third time and finally passed this 2nd day of Sept. 1986.
