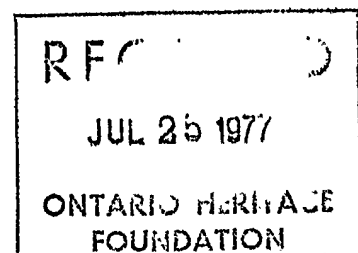


Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Heustadt, on the 4th day of July, 1977, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as Lot 7 of Plan 164 on Barbara Street West, as a property of historical value or interest under the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Right Honourable John George Diefenbaker, former Prime Minister of Canada was born in the house on this property on September 18th, 1895. The house was built about 1890 and is recommended for designation for its historical association in the life of a great Canadian Statesman.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 18th day of July, 1977.
