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3 BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE TOWNSHIP OF
WELLESLEY COUNCIL CHAMBERS IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF WELLESLEY TO BE OF
HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE
OR INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O.
1980 c. 337 as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality to
enact the By-laws to designate real property, include all buildings
and structures thereon to be of architectural and historic value or
interest:

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township
of Wellesley has caused to be served on the owner of the lands and
premises known as The Township of Wellesley Council Chambers being
Part 1, 58R-610, Lot 1, Part Lot 2 Hutchison's Survey, Plan 616,
Crosshill, Township of Wellesley and upon the Ontario Heritage
Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real
property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in
the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality
once for each of these consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation
has been served on the clerk of the municipality;


THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township
of Wellesley enacts as follows:

1. The property described in Schedule A attached hereto is hereby
designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest;
2. Section 33(1) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 c. 337
shall apply only to the following exterior elevations:
 - (a) South, Regional Road 5 facade - rubble stone, 3 bays, in the
Venacular Classical Revival style.
 - (b) East, Township Road #12, original 1855 building, rubble stone.
 - (c) West, original 1855 building - rubble stone.
 - (d) Roof of the entire structure - boxed cornice with return,
clapboard pediment.

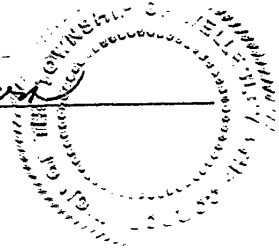
3. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wellesley.
