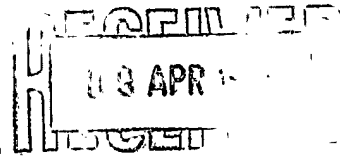

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE PLACES OF ARCHITECTURAL
AND/OR HISTORICAL VALUE IN THE CITY OF ST. THOMAS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, that the Council of the Corporation of the City of St. Thomas intends to designate as places of architectural and/or historical value or interest the following properties:

1. 33-33½ St. George Street
2. Wellington Street Public School, 50 Wellington Street

The detailed reasons for designation of these properties can be seen in or obtained from the Office of the Clerk, City Hall, 545 Talbot Street, St. Thomas, Ontario, during normal office hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday). Any person who objects to any of these intended designations must within thirty days after the date of the first publication, serve on the City Clerk, a notice of objection in writing, setting out the reason for the objection and all relevant facts. The first publication date is April 3rd, 1996 and the last day for filing an objection to the intended designations is **May 3rd, 1996**.
