NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham on the 13th day of April, 1982, passed a motion of intention to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as 9251 Highway 48 North, Markham, as a property of architectural and/or historic interest or value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Ambrose Noble House at 9251 Highway 48 North, is recommended for designation for architectural reasons as a well preserved example of a Mid-nineteenth century farmhouse. It not only exhibits formal characteristics of the neo-classical and Regency styles but also portrays unique details that reflect its rural location and the personal idiosyncrasies of its builder.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty (30) days of the 28th day of April, 1982.
