TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Markham intends to designate the property, including land and building, known municipally as 7668 Highway 7, Markham, as a property of architectural and/or historic interest or value under Part 1V of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18.

A Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation of The Locust Hill United Church is outlined hereunder:

> The red brick church was built in 1890 as the home of the Wesleyan Methodist congregation of the hamlet of Locust Hill and provides an excellent example of the Gothic Revival Style with outstanding decorative brick and window detailing. The church forms part of an historic grouping with other remaining features and buildings of the community of Locust Hill.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served on the Town Clerk within thirty (30) days of October 12th, 1994.
