NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Markham on the 19th day of December, 1983, passed a Notice of Intention to designate the property, including part of lands and building, known municipally as The David Wismer House - Lots 70 and 71, R.P. 65M-2193 (or part thereof) (Part of Lot 15, Concession 7 - south side of Sixteenth Avenue, east of McCowan Road, Markham) as a property of architectural and/or historic interest or value under Part 1V of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The David Wismer House on 16th Avenue is recommended for designation for its historical and architectural significance as an excellent example of an Ontario style farmhouse built by one of Markham's leading Mennonite families. Architecturally the house is a well preserved example of a mid-nineteenth century farmhouse that exhibits many refined architectural features in the Regency style.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty (30) days of the 28th day of December, 1983.
