NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham on the 11th day of March, 1980, passed a motion of intention to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as 20 Peter Street, Markham, Ontario, as a property of architectural and/or historic interest or value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation

The dwelling located at 20 Peter Street in Markham is recommended for designation as a fine example of a rural adaption of the Picturesque-Gothic Revival style, popular in domestic architecture during the second half of the nineteenth century.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty (30) days of the 3rd day of April, 1980.
