NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham, on the 14th day of February, 1978, passed a motion of intention to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as 10 Colborne Street, Thornhill, Ontario, as a property of architectural and/or historical interest or value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, R.S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The building at 10 Colborne Street, Thornhill, now the Thornhill Village Library, is recommended for designation for architectural reasons as a unique example of a modest domestic building of the Classical Revival style. The clapboard building sits with its gable end to the street.

The building was erected in 1851 as a home for Mrs. S. Ramsden. It has recently undergone excellent restoration.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty (30) days of the 8th day of March, 1978.
