TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as 6066 Elgin Mills Road East, Markham as a property of architectural and/or historic interest or value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Joseph Barkey Stone Farmhouse is recommended for designation for its historical and architectural significance.

The 1½-storey, stone dwelling constructed in 1862 by Joseph Barkey provides an outstanding example of 19th century stone masonry craftsmanship. Five successive generations of the Barkey family, one of Markham's most prominent Pennsylvania German Mennonite families, occupied the property.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served on the Town Clerk within thirty (30) days of the 13th day of November, 1993.
