**TAKE NOTICE THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Windsor refuses to repeal the heritage designation By-law No. 47-1999 for the property, including lands and buildings known as the Patrice Parent House, 4371 Riverside Drive East under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act as per M383-2015.

Any person may, within thirty days of the receipt of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Windsor notice of his or her objection to the refusal to repeal the designation by-law, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Windsor shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
