BY-LAW NUMBER

472-94

A by-law to repeal By-law 549-82, a by-law to designate the Brown-Vooro House located at 620 Derry Road, as being of architectural value and historical interest

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga enacted By-law 549-82 on the 9th day of August, 1982, designating the lands and buildings known as the Brown-Vooro House, as a property being of architectural value and historical interest under the Ontario Heritage Act;

AND WHEREAS the lands being the subject matter of By-law 549-82 were described as being composed of part of Lot 10, Concession 2, West of Hurontario Street and are municipally known as 620 Derry Road in the City of Mississauga;

AND WHEREAS the owner of 620 Derry Road, had requested approval of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga, to remove the heritage designation on this property;

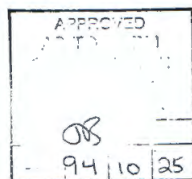
AND WHEREAS under the Ontario Heritage Act, RSO 1990, c. 0.18, where the Council fails to notify the applicant of its decision within ninety days, the Council shall be deemed to have consented to the application;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga did not respond to the request to remove the heritage designation on this property within ninety days of receipt thereof;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law 549-82, a by-law to designate the Brown-Vooro House located at 620 Derry Road, in the City of Mississauga, as being of architectural value and historical interest, is hereby repealed.
2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Mississauga;
3. That the City Solicitor is hereby directed to register a copy of this by-law against the subject property.
