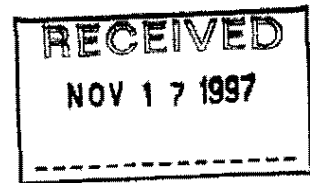

Notice of Intention of Designate


Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Stratford intends to designate the property at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Section 29, of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18.

119 Mornington Street – Reasons for Designation:

119 Mornington Street is an Italianate style house built in 1888. Original elements of the structure which are part of the reasons for designation are; brickwork, front bay window, eave brackets, bargeboard at gables, decorative woodwork on dormer gable, wood windows and stone foundation.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts, shall be served on the Clerk-Administrator of the City of Stratford, within 30 days of this notice.
