TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Stratford intends to designate the properties, at the following municipal addresses as properties of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV, of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

- (a) MUNICIPAL ADDRESS: Bandshell, Lakeside Drive
REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION; The Bandshell was built in 1929, after much dispute about its shape and location. It is architecturally significant, not only to Stratford, but also to the surrounding area. R. Thomas Orr suggested the shell-like shape after seeing such a structure in the United States. The design of the Bandshell introduced a new concept to the traditional hexagonal-shaped bandstand. Later, London and Toronto reproduced the design to create their own bandshells. Toronto's bandshell is a well known landmark within the Canadian National Exhibition grounds. The exterior and interior features of the Bandshell will be included in the designation.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts shall be served on the Clerk of the City of Stratford, before the 4th day of April, 1989.
