NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE A BUILDING OF CULTURAL HERITAGE VALUE OR INTEREST

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Aurora intends to designate the following property as a property of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest pursuant to the provisions of Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18, as amended. A brief statement of reasons is included.

Description of Property

The property known municipally as 15199 Yonge Street contains a 2 storey brick commercial building located in the heart of Aurora's historic downtown on the east side of Yonge Street.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

Grimshaw's Bakery was constructed in 1908 for Herbert Grimshaw, an established baker. The construction happened at a time where Aurora was experiencing economic renewal from depression in the 1890's. In 1919, the building was sold to Cecil M. Norris, a grocer. While he did not own the site for very long, other food retailers and bakers would continue to occupy the building into the 1960s. Between 1933 and 1946, the Pattersons operated a bakery and soda fountain; a small wall paining on the north wall of the structure is still visible today. The building continues to be used for commercial purposes.

Description of Heritage Attributes

Important to the preservation of the property are the original key attributes that express its value, which include:

Exterior Elements

- overall 2 storey brick commercial building;
- fenestration on the front elevation features two windows on the second storey, each capped by a parged brick lintel;
- An excellent example of Aurora's commercial architecture in the early 1900's with its flat roof, brick cornice, corbels, red brick and brick work.
