## Notice of Approval with Conditions

The Heritage Preservation Office of the City of Peterborough has reviewed your Heritage Permit application for the property known municipally as 220 Brock Street.

The City has determined that the proposed work is not entirely in keeping with the values of preservation outlined in the Ontario Heritage Act, and may have an adverse impact on the heritage attributes of your property. Having met with your agent Neil White, we understand that modifications to scope of work will be made.

The following proposed alterations have been approved:

- Reconstruction of the porch on the Brock Street side of the property maintaining existing look
- · Replacement of existing decking
- · Second storey door to be made inoperable
- Replacement of upper story wooden railing with wrought iron railing

The approval of your application is conditional on the following changes being made to the proposed work:

- Retention or replication of decorative woodwork on the entablature including moulding, dentils, and bead
- Use of wooden tapered columns, instead of fibreglass, or reuse of existing columns if structurally sound

In speaking to Mr. White, I understand that the project specifications will be amended to ensure that the heritage attributes of the property are fully conserved and that he will be in contact with the Heritage Preservation Office with regards to the sourcing of the columns. As the majority of the proposed alterations have been approved, I have enclosed your Heritage Permit such that work on the reconstruction of the porch can
