THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF MISSISSAUGA

BY-LAW NUMBER ...72-92.

A by-law to repeal By-law 11-87 designating the Codlin House, located at 7097-7103 Airport Road being composed of that portion of Lot 11, Concession 7 Southern Division (Part 1 on Plan of Survey 43R-14065) in the City of Mississauga, in the Province of Ontario

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga enacted By-law No. 11-87 on the 12th day of January, 1987, designating the lands and buildings known as the Codlin House, as a property being of architectural importance under the Ontario Heritage Act;

AND WHEREAS, the lands being the subject matter of By-law No. 11-87 were described as being composed of that portion of Lot 11, Concession 7 Southern Division, being Part 1 on Plan of Survey 43R-14065, and are municipally known as 7097-7103 Airport Road, in the City of Mississauga;

AND WHEREAS, the owner of 7097-7103 Airport Road, has requested approval of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga, to remove the heritage designation on this property;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga, deems it desirable that the designation on this property be removed;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law No. 11-87, a by-law to designate the Codlin House presently located at 7097-7103 Airport Road, in the City of Mississauga, as being of architectural importance, is hereby repealed.
2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of 7097-7103 Airport Road, and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation, and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Mississauga;
3. The City Solicitor is hereby directed to register a copy of this by-law against the subject property, being composed of that portion of Lot 11, Concession 7 Southern Division, being Part 1 on Plan of Survey 43R-14065, as set out in Schedule 'A' attached hereto.
