CLONMEL ESTATE: REASONS FOR DESIGNATION UNDER THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, 1990, CHAPTER 0.18

Of the 10,000 acres of land that soldier and United Empire Loyalist, William Francis had reserved on behalf of twelve families in Nova Scotia, he selected for himself a valuable mill site and the adjacent hill - the hill upon which Clonmel Estate is located today.

When Mr. William Henry "Harry" Barrett built a new home, he chose this site and a style reminiscent of the early Loyalist homes of Norfolk. It is grand but not pretentious. Local workmen and materials were used and the construction is poured concrete throughout.

The following features are specifically noted for their architectural significance:

Exterior - all exterior elevations

- roofline brackets and panelling of the soffit
- original window, doors and shutters
- west columned porch and railing
- the porte-cochere and windowed entry
- the kitchen entry
- chimneys
- stone wall

Interior - woodwork of the diningroom including the door framing, alcove, built-in china cabinet and radiator covers.
