



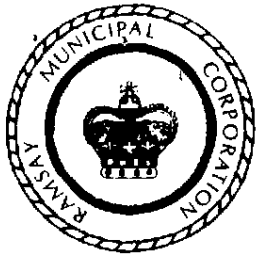

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**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REPEAL
DESIGNATING BY-LAW 90-32**

IN THE MATTER OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT,
R.S.O., 1990, CHAPTER 0.18

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ramsay intends to repeal By-Law 90-32 which designated the lands and buildings known municipally as the East Half of Lot 25, Concession 3.

The reason for repealing By-Law 90-32 is due to the fact that the owner dismantled completely the building in question, thus regating the architectural reasons for designation.

Any person within 30 days of the first publication of this Notice, mail by Registered Mail or by hand, deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Ramsay notice of his or her objection to the proposed repealing by-law, together with a statement of the reasons for the objections and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ramsay shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RAMSAY

BY-LAW NO. 94-10

BEING a By-Law to repeal By-Law 90-32.

WHEREAS Section 31 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18 permits the Council of the Municipality in which the property is situated to repeal the By-Law designating the property;

WHEREAS the Council intends to dedesignate the property known municipally as the East Half of Lot 25, Concession 3;

AND WHEREAS the Local Advisory Committee has been consulted.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ramsay hereby enacts as follows:


1. That Council repeal By-Law 90-32 in its entirety.
2. That a copy of the repealing By-Law be served on the owner and the Heritage Foundation.
3. That the property be deleted from the Register referred to in subsection 27(1).
4. That notice of the repealing By-Law be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality.
5. That a copy of the repealing By-Law be registered against the property affected in the proper land registry office.

BY-LAW read a first and second time this 5th. day of April, 1994.

BY-LAW read a third time and finally passed this 5th. day of April, 1994.
