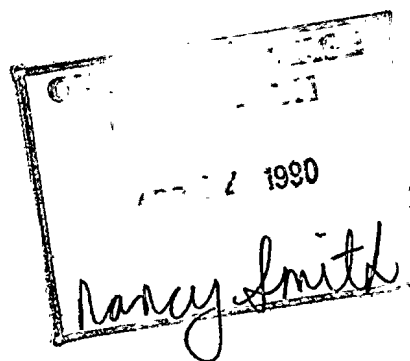

BY-LAW NUMBER 90-914

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS THE BRIGHTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING, REGISTERED PLAN 43, LOT 19, FORMERLY KNOWN AS PART LOT 3, CONCESSION 5, R.R.#7 BRIGHTON ONTARIO, KOKIHO, AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1980 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brighton has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as The Brighton Township Municipal Building, Registered Plan 43, Lot 19, formerly known as Part Lot 3, Concession 5, R.R.#7 Brighton, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRIGHTON enacts as follows:

1. There shall be designated as being of architectural and historical value the real property known as the Brighton Township Municipal Building, Registered Plan 43, Lot 19, R.R.#7, in the Township of Brighton.
2. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized to cause copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described above.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owners of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause a notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED at the Township of Brighton, Ontario this 5th day of April, 1990.
