NOTICE OF DECISION



Take notice that the Council of the Corporation
of the City of Toronto on the 10th day of February, 1986,
having considered the application for consent to demolish
the building known municipally as 2 Strachan Avenue, and
after giving consideration to the matter, decided:

- (A) THAT THE CITY OF TORONTO REFUSE THE
APPLICATION TO DEMOLISH THE PROPERTY
AT 2 STRACHAN AVENUE KNOWN AS THE
MUSIC BUILDING WHICH IS DESIGNATED BY
BY-LAW BY CITY COUNCIL UNDER PART IV
OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT AND IN
ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 34 OF SAID
ACT, PROHIBIT ANY WORK TO DEMOLISH OR
REMOVE ANY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE ON THE
PROPERTY FOR A PERIOD OF 180 DAYS FROM
THE DATE OF ITS DECISION.
- (B) THAT THE OWNER BE REQUESTED TO MEET
FURTHER WITH THE TORONTO HISTORICAL BOARD
AND OTHER APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS REGARDING
THE FUTURE OF THIS PROPERTY.
