This is to advise that Kitchener City Council, at its meeting of January 24, 1994, passed the following resolution:

"That pursuant to Section 33 of the Ontario Heritage Act, we approve the request of the owner to alter the designated property known municipally as 191-197 King Street West (P.U.C. Building) by erecting a roof sign, substantially of size and appearance as shown on the plan provided to the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee on December 10, 1993; and further
