**Pt. Lot 24, Concession 5, Smith Ward – Johnson Bickell Cemetery**

The Corporation of the Township of Selwyn by the Council thereof hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the hereinafter described property be and is hereby designated to be of historical and architectural value or interest pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. 0.18, for the reasons hereafter stated:

**a) Lot 24, Concession 5, Smith Ward**

Reason for Designation

Johnson Bickell Cemetery constitutes an early example of the family burial plot in what is now Selwyn Township. It exists as a tangible reminder of the traditions surrounding death and burial in nineteenth century rural Ontario, and is illustrative of the cultural, landscape and settlement patterns of the period.


Heritage Attributes

- Rural character of the landscape immediately surrounding the markers


