BY-LAW NUMBER 42-19

BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE ILLMAN CEMETERY,14275 MARSH HILL ROAD, PORT PERRY AS BEING OF HERITAGE VALUE OR INTEREST

WHEREAS pursuant to Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, the Council of a municipality is authorized to enact by-laws to designate a real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon, to be of cultural heritage value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Scugog is the owner of the Hillman Cemetery at 14275 Marsh Hill Road, Port Perry, and has caused to be served upon the Ontario Heritage Trust the notice of intention to designate Hillman Cemetery;

AND WHEREAS Council's intention to so designate has been duly advertised with no objections thereto;

AND WHEREAS the reasons for the designation are set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCUGOG enacts as follows:

1. THAT the following real property, more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law is hereby designated as being of cultural heritage value or interest:

Hillman Cemetery 14275 Marsh Hill Road PORT PERRY, Ontario

 THAT the Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-Law to be registered against the properties described in Schedule "A" attached hereto in the Land Registry Office.

Description of Property - Hillman Cemetery, Marsh Hill Road, Utica

The Hillman Cemetery is a church yard cemetery located at the northern edge of the cross roads community of Utica, Ontario on the east side of the Marsh Hill Road.

It is an active cemetery that consists of 207 grave markers ranging from the Carrera marble of the mid-19th century, to the coloured granites of the 20th century.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

The Hillman Cemetery has cultural heritage value as a rural Ontario church yard cemetery that provides information on the lives of families who began to settle this part of this Ontario in the 1830's and were associated with the adjacent Wesleyan Methodist Church constructed in 1871.

The Hillman Cemetery is characterized by a neatly kept lawn scattered with, and bordered by large trees located in behind the existing classical revival brick church building.

Description of Heritage Attributes

Key attributes of the Hillman Cemetery that reflect its value as a link to the early history of Reach Township and the hamlet of Utica, and as an example of a small 19th century rural church yard cemetery are:

- Its manicured lawn;
- Its mix of large deciduous and coniferous shade trees located in, and along its boundary;
- The variety of styles, materials and symbolism represented in the markers and monuments;
- The range of size and sophistication of markers from modest to elaborate:
- · Its location, orientation and dimensions;
- · Its association with the brick United Church building.
