Please be advised that at the Council meeting of the Township of Scugog held May 27, 2019, Council indicated its intent to designate Scovill's Cemetery, 17100 Island Road, Port Perry, Ontario, as a property of cultural heritage value or interest under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act* (the Act). This notice is being served in accordance with Section 29 of the Act.

Description of Property- Scovill's Cemetery, 17100 Island Road, Scugog Island, Ontario

Scovill's Cemetery is an abandoned farm cemetery tucked away from the view of the road but having a beautiful view of Lake Scugog to the west. The cemetery consists of 157 grave markers which commemorate the lives of the early settlers of Scugog Island.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

The Scovill's Cemetery has cultural heritage value as small rural Ontario cemetery that provides information on the lives of the pioneer families of Scugog Island.

Scovill's Cemetery is characterized by a roughly kept lawn surrounded by a border of wildflowers and tree with a scenic view of Lake Scugog. The cemetery consists of modest stone grave markers from the 19th and early 20th century.

Description of Heritage Attributes

Key attributes of Scovill's Cemetery that reflect its value as a link to the early history of Scugog Island and as an example of a small 19th century rural cemetery include:

- Its roughly maintained lawn
- The banks of wildflowers and trees which border the property;
- The variety of styles, materials and symbolism represented in the markers and monuments;
- The farm wire fence that encloses the property;
- · Its location, orientation, dimensions and views of Lake Scugog.
